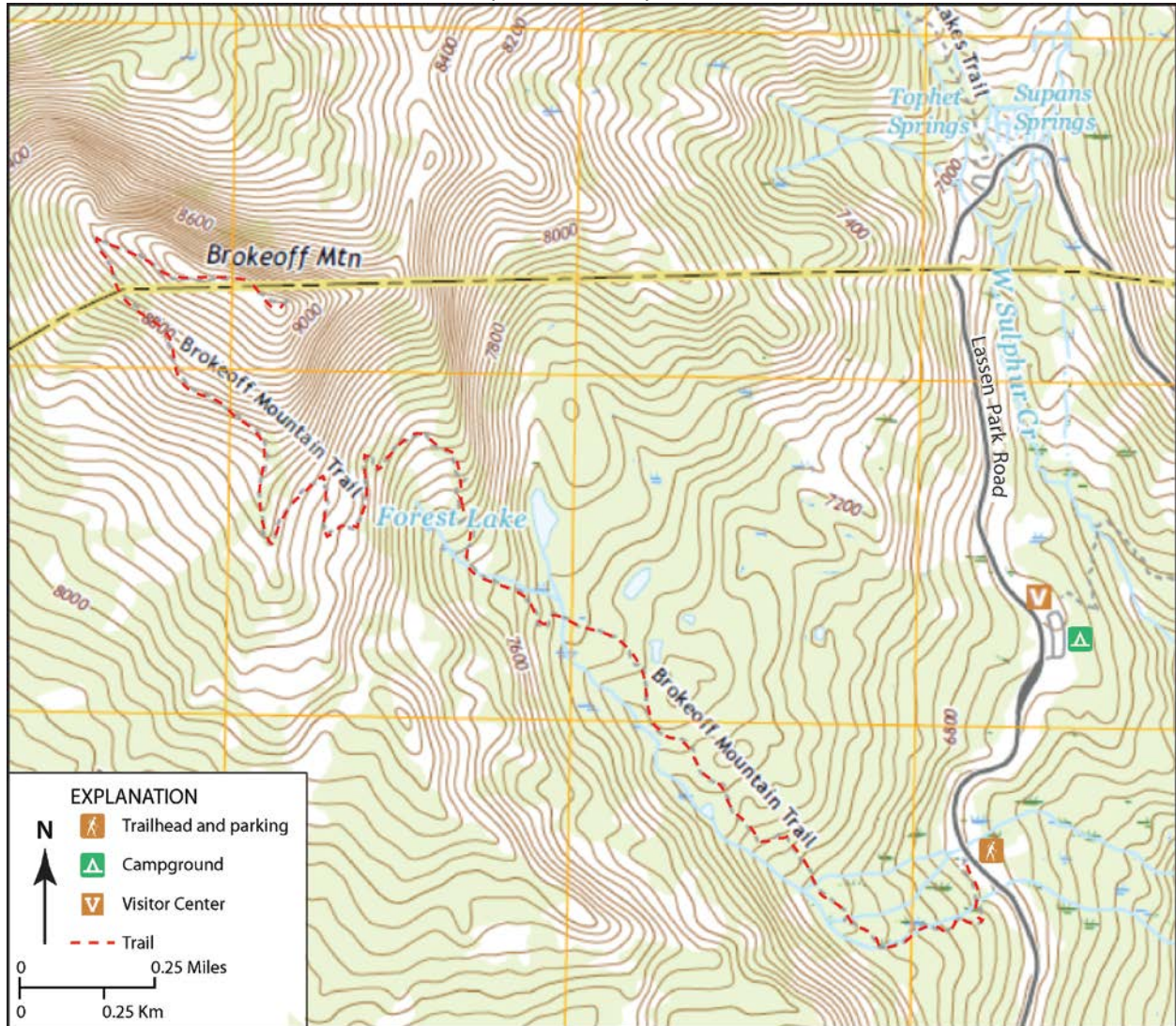
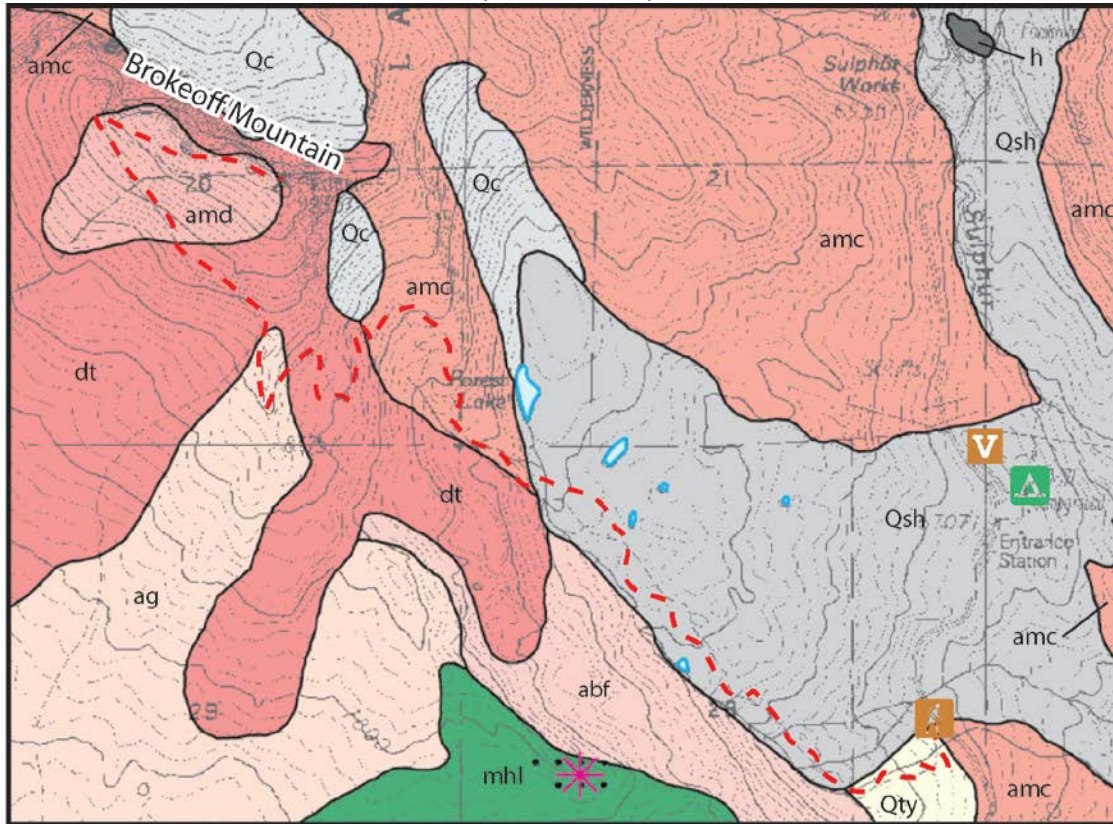


Figure H1.1. Brokeoff Mountain trail map.
